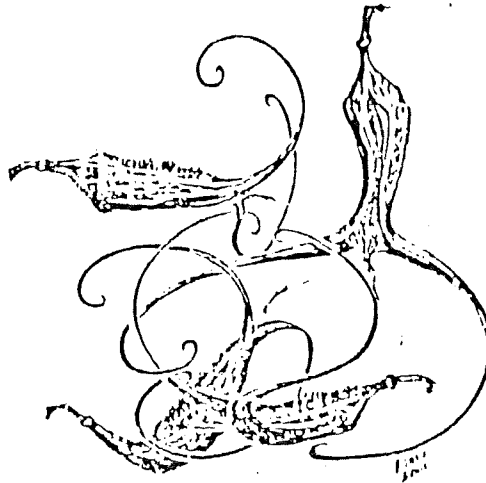

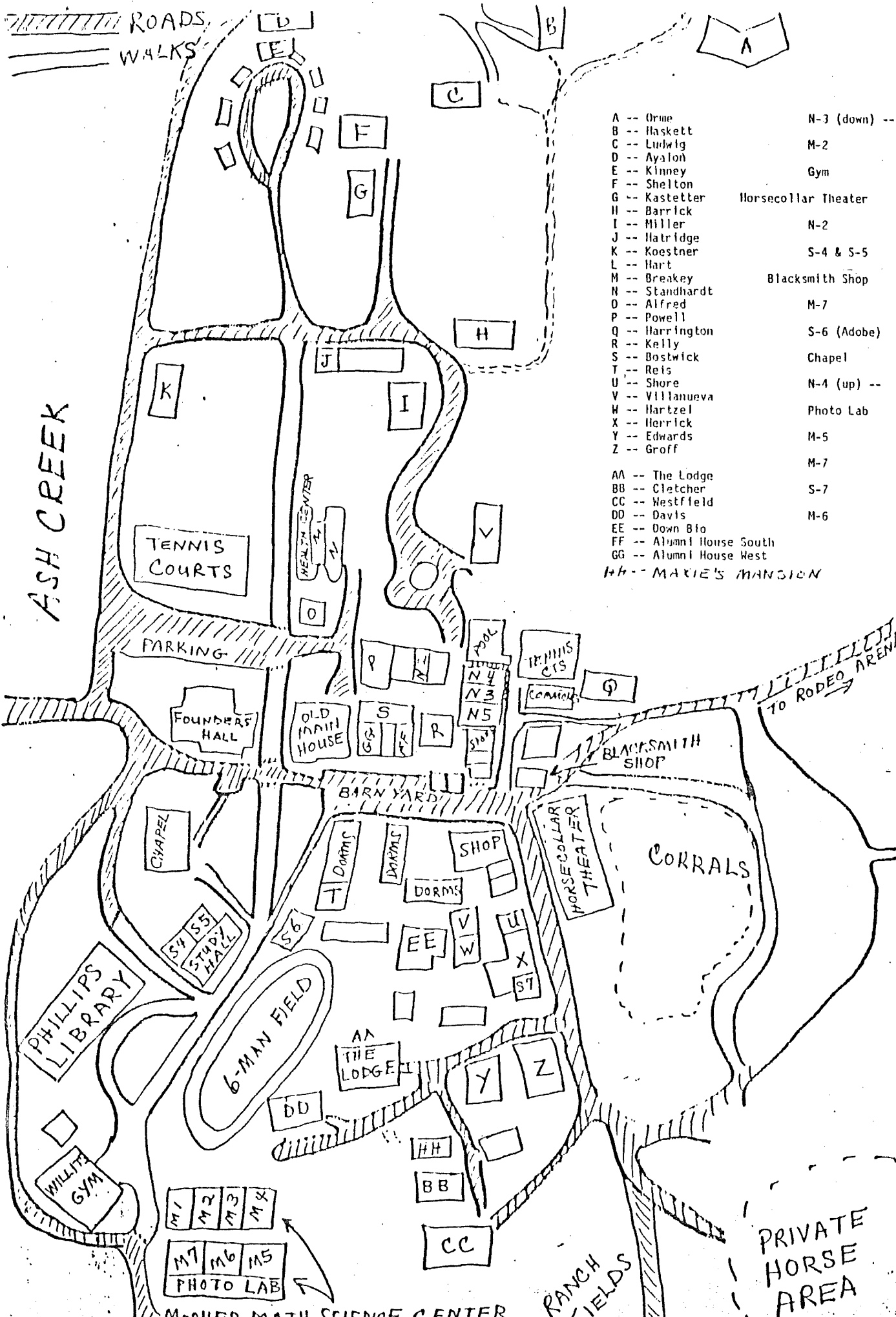

and anyone looking for a good time in the dark...

As a special attraction during this year's Fine Arts Festival, we are pleased to offer a five evening program of feature films to be presented twice daily starting on Sunday the 26th and running through Thursday the 30th of January in the Fireplace Cinema (better known as the Study Hall) at 4:15 and 8:45 PM. These films can be seen for the special price of \$5 for all the films or \$2 per showing with proceeds from the showings going to the Fine Arts Festival budget. Advance Series Tickets may be purchased from Mr. Haskett or Mr. Powell. Single admissions may be purchased at the door on a "space available" basis.

Features to be shown are:

DAYS OF HEAVEN (1978 American film directed by Terrence Malick (BADLANDS) and starring Richard Gere, Brooke Adams, Linda Manz and Sam Shepard)
Beautifully filmed and gently narrated drama of the plight of three migrant workers who have fled the urban jungle of Chicago, in 1916, for the fields of the Texas Panhandle. Strong, naturalistic cinema you will be unable to forget.

LOCAL HERO (1983 Scotch film directed by Bill Forsyth (GREGORY'S GIRL) and starring Peter Riegert, Burt Lancaster and Jenny Seagrove)
Soft social comedy concerns the conflict between big business and environmental concerns as reflected in the visit by a young Houston engineer to a small village on the Scotch coast. Very, very enjoyable film with a fine musical score by Mark Knopfler of Dire Straits.

THIEF (1981 American thriller in the existential mode directed by Michael Mann, the producer and creative guide behind MIAMI VICE, and starring James Caan, Tuesday Weld, Willie Nelson and Robert Prosky.)
Taut, evocative study of a brilliant criminal involved in high-tech heists. Mann's frames are relentless studies in precision; nothing in the film is wasted effort. Fine Caan and supporting performances.

CARMEN (1983 Spanish film directed by Carlos Saura (BLOOD WEDDING) and starring Antonio Gades, Christina Hoyos and Laura del Sol)
Incredibly moving, even driven, study of a dance company's rehearsal of a presentation of Bizet's story ... the lines between the story of the dance and the lives of the performers continually merge and blur.

THE LAST WAVE (1978 Australian film directed by Peter Weir (WITNESS) and starring Richard Chamberlain, Gulpilil and Nandjiwarra Amagula)
Unusual mystery set in metropolitan Sydney where an aborigine is killed and other aborigines are tried for his murder. Chamberlain is an attorney drawn in to defend the peoples and to learn and be puzzled by the ways of the tribes. Strange, haunting film by one of the most respected directors of his country and now our own.
